Davis Lake ID's

Did you know that your pool pass/photo ID is also your Davis Lake membership card? Well, it is! The DL Board would like to encourage everyone to carry their ID card with them whenever they attend social events, and use the common grounds (pool, tennis courts, clubhouse, walking trails and lake) to help with neighborhood safety.

If you lost your ID from last year or are new to the neighborhood, make it down to the clubhouse to have your photo taken and ID issued. Photos cannot be emailed.

The following dates & times have been designated for collecting up to date facility usage contracts, issuing new or replacement ID cards and issuing stickers to all cards once a contract has been submitted. Stop in to have your ID card issued. Please bring identification with your Davis Lake address. All homeowners & tenants with assigned rights may stop in to get their ID's. For new ID cards each household member listed on the facility usage age 6 and up will need to have their photo taken at the clubhouse. ID cards are required by all DL residents with privilege to the amenities. Do not wait until the last minute you will need your card updated for access to the pool. The pool opens May 21st. Spring Has Sprung and It's Time to Get Our Hands Dirty

It's just the right time to think about that summer garden! The sun is shining and many of us are getting that bug!!! There are lots of vegetables that grow well in our area. With the economy in a slump, we are all trying to save money and conserve. It may be comforting to know that you can avoid spending money on some of your weekly salad ingredients and fresh vegetables very soon!!! Most garden vegetables should be planted after the threat of the last frost (Easter weekend is usually that landmark). Other varieties can be planted now and some can be started as seeds inside, and then transferred to your garden space later. Here is some information to help you get started.

Peppers and Lettuce can be planted now. Soil should be rich with manure and compost materials to help drain. Raised beds are preferred for drainage. Cover soil with mulch to hold in moisture. While plants are young, make sure they are somewhat protected from harsh sun (plastic canopy is suggested). Lettuce takes about 4 weeks to harvest and keeps on giving for weeks! By planting about 6 plants, you can enjoy garden fresh salad for weeks!

After the last threat of frost (Easter weekend) you can plant seeds or young plants right into your garden. Vegetables that grow well, and aren't hard to maintain, include, tomatoes, cucumbers and beans (use a trellis – they are vines), squash (both zucchini and yellow grow well), carrots and radishes. Melons are also easy to grow, but need large open spaces as they "crawl" and get large. If you start with good, rich soil that includes manure, and plenty of compost material, your plants should be happy and healthy. A little fertilizer boots growth and mulch on top of the soil will help the young roots hold moisture. Plants should be watered in the am so allow the water to soak in and not evaporate too quickly!

Annual flowers should also be planted after the danger of the last frost has gone. Happy Spring & Happy Planting!!!

What makes a Lawn...LAWN OF THE MONTH???

This is our favorite time of year to drive around our beautiful neighborhood and see what people are up to. Thicker grass, new flower beds, walls made of stone or brick, new pathways, annual flowers freshly planted, new bushes, newly planted trees and perennials coming up again for a glimpse at the sun!!! We would like to remind all of you, what we look for when judging...and what makes a beautiful yard/lawn a candidate for "Lawn of the Month".

Most of us take pride in our lawns. After all, it is one of the first things people notice when they drive up to your house! It can make a really good first impression, or one that is not so good. The Minimum Maintenance recommended for keeping your yard looking terrific, includes the following:

- Mowing the grass regularly – especially in the spring, when there's so much rain and it's growing so quickly!
- Keeping bushes around your home trimmed so that they do not obstruct walkways, stairs or windows.
- Keeping your flower beds free of weeds.
- Adding fresh pine straw or mulch seasonally to fill and cover dirt.
- Making sure you don't have any grass growing between the cracks on your driveway.
- The mailbox area is attractive and you should be able to see the street numbers clearly from the road (also an ARC requirement).
- Make sure that your trashcan is on the side of your home, not in front where it's visible (another ARC requirement).

The "Lawn of the Month" is usually awarded to a home that meets the following criteria:

- A recent effort has been made to improve the lawn.
- The grass is lush and healthy.
- Weeds are under control (they don't have to be gone...we all know that's virtually impossible).
- Seasonal flowers are always a plus.
- Flower beds that are popping with lots of color.

- Flower pots filled with beautiful color.
- Most of all...it looks great and is a reflection of your personality and effort!
- All types of lawns can win... not just the one with the most flowers or best grass... etc. We award LOM for overall best effort!

So, we urge you to get out there and make your lawn all it can be! Thanks and good luck to all of you and as always..."Happy Planting".

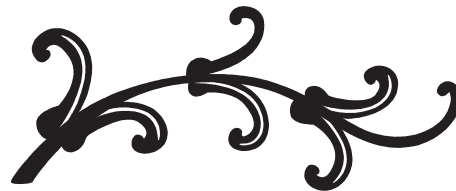
